

3. The current wind farm project proposed by Horizon Wind does not have adequate scientific research or support to conclusively determine that the existence of the wind turbines will not adversely impact the Loch Lomond watershed lands or the moose and other wildlife and vegetation as traditionally hunted or harvested within the watershed lands.

4. Community members are concerned that the proposed wind farm project will threaten Loch Lomond as a viable source of potable water and express their view that any such proposed development will pose unacceptable risks to Loch Lomond and its value as a potable water source.

5. There is no adequate mitigation of the adverse impacts of the proposed wind farm project, and the project will adversely impact the aboriginal, historical and treaty rights of the members of Fort William First nation.

The community members have been quite clear and unequivocal on their opposition to the Horizon Wind farm project, as set out above.
