## HEALTH

The Health Program provides services to Band members of all ages within the Life Cycle. Some services are limited to on reserve population.

### Services include:

Intake, referrals, assessment, planning, advocacy and support.

Services are provided by the Health Team comprised of the CHN, CHR, CHR-Clerk, Diabetes Educator, Registered Dental Hygienist and the Medical Van Operator.

### Programs provided include:

- Limited community nursing services are provided to members.
- Coordination of Medical Transportation arrangements in the City of Thunder Bay and out of the Thunder Bay Area are provided to members.

- Oral health initiative program (all ages)

## FAMILY SUPPORT/ADDICTIONS

The Family Support program provides service to Band Members for Family Support, Prevention and Child Protection.
