Re: PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER ADVISORY RECOMMENDED
Affected Residences: 662 City Road to 724 City Road, 1 Quarry Road to 8 Quarry Road
and the trailer park (anticipated July 03, 2024) Fort William First Nation

This advisory notice will confirm that Nokiiwin Tribal Council recommends a precautionary Boil Water Advisory for 662 City Rd (east of James St S / Bannon's Gas Bar) to 724 City Rd (west of Back St), 1 Quarry Rd to 8 Quarry Rd, and the trailer park due to scheduled repairs to the distribution system, that will result loss of pressure in the distribution system because of a halt in the water supply. At that time water from the drinking water system cannot be guaranteed to be safe. The water supply will be **shut down** from **8am until 5pm on July3, 2024**.

It is requested that the residents affected by this service disruption are informed that a PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER ADVISORY is being recommended on July 3, 2024

Affected residents should be advised to boil all drinking water from the community water supply for at least one full minute then allowed to cool. Water from an approved potable source may also be provided.

Once pressure is restored, this Precautionary Boil Water Advisory should remain in place until the following measures are actioned and confirmed:

1. Water samples are obtained from the affected residences of City Road and Quarry Road. Sampling and analysis will be conducted by the City of Thunder Bay's Environment Division and will be collected 24 hours apart and submitted for microbiological analysis to an accredited laboratory. The analytical results of those samples must confirm the absence of E. Coli and Total Coliform bacteria.
2. The free available chlorine residual should be measured and confirmed to be not less than 0.2 mg/L throughout the distribution system.

Please find enclosed a 'Boil Your Water' advisory notice that outlines how to safely use water during a boil water advisory.
