THIS REQUEST FOR QUOTE (“RFQ”) IS A SOLICITATION FOR QUOTATION AND IS NOT A CONTRACT OR AN OFFER TO CONTRACT.

1.0 General Requirements and Bid Award

- 1.1 This RFQ form must be signed and returned with bidder's proposal for the services and products described in Schedule 1 (the “**Services and Products**”). Failure to sign and return this form and to comply with all requirements described herein may result in disqualification.
- 1.2 Resolute FP Canada Inc. (“**Resolute**”) reserves the right to withdraw this RFQ at anytime before quotations are due; to accept or reject any or all proposals; to waive any formalities or minor technical inconsistencies or delete any items or requirements from this RFQ or resulting contract; to accept all, or any part of, a bidder's proposal at the quoted prices; and to award the contract that is the subject of this RFQ to one or more bidders.
- 1.3 Representations made within the proposal will be binding on responding bidder. Resolute will not be bound to act by any communication or proposal submitted by bidders other than in accordance with this RFQ (as amended from time to time in writing by Resolute, as applicable).
- 1.4 Bidder's questions and Resolute's responses may, or may not be forwarded to all bidders. Resolute reserves the right to communicate all or part of the questions and responses, with all, or certain bidders.
- 1.5 Resolute may, at its discretion, request a second pass bid on all, or certain items, at any time during the proposal process. Resolute may request a second pass bid from all, or certain bidders. Resolute may, at its discretion, advise all, or certain bidders, of its decision to a second pass bid.
- 1.6 Bidder awarded a contract under this RFQ will be that bidder whose quotation, as presented in its response to this RFQ, provides best value to Resolute, acting in its sole discretion, including without limitation, price, on-time delivery, warranty, quality and service, alignment with Resolute corporate values and mission, and such other factors determined from time to time by Resolute.
- 1.7 A contract may be negotiated with one or more bidder(s). Resolute may, at its discretion, reject or accept any proposal or contract negotiation.
- 1.8 By submitting a proposal in response to this RFQ, bidder is deemed to accept the award selection process and criteria and Resolute's discretion in connection with such process and criteria.
- 1.9 By submitting a proposal in response to this RFQ, bidder acknowledges and waives any claim for any compensation of any kind whatsoever against Resolute or any of its Representatives (as defined below), as a result of its submission of a proposal, any decision made by Resolute during the RFQ process, including when acting in its sole discretion, or arising in any other manner from its participation in this RFQ.

2.0 Bidder's Affirmations

By submitting its bid, bidder represents and warrants the following:

- 2.1 Bidder acknowledges and agrees that (1) this RFQ is a solicitation for a quotation and is not a contract or an offer to contract; (2) the submission of a quotation by bidder in response to this RFQ will not create a contract between Resolute and bidder; (3) Resolute makes no representation or warranty, written or oral, that one or more contracts will be awarded under this RFQ; and (4) bidder will bear, as its sole risk and responsibility, any cost arising from bidder's preparation of a response to this RFQ and, as applicable, contract negotiation.
- 2.2 Bidder is a reputable person that is lawfully and regularly engaged in providing the Products and/or performing the Services.
- 2.3 Bidder has the necessary experience, knowledge, abilities, skills, and resources to provide the Products and/or perform the Services upon the terms and conditions specified in this RFQ.
- 2.4 Bidder is aware of, is fully informed about, and is in full compliance with all applicable federal, state and local laws, rules, regulations and ordinances including, without limitation, those relating to bid rigging.
- 2.5 Bidder understands (i) the requirements and specifications set forth in this RFQ and (ii) the terms and conditions set forth under which bidder will be required to operate.
- 2.6 If selected by Resolute, bidder will not delegate any of its duties or responsibilities under this RFQ or any resulting contract to any subcontractor, except as expressly provided in the contract.
- 2.7 If selected by Resolute, bidder will maintain any insurance coverage required by the contract during the term thereof.
- 2.8 If selected by Resolute, bidder will comply with Resolute's environmental, health and safety, site and other corporate policies, requirements and procedures, as amended by Resolute from time to time.
- 2.9 All statements, information and representations prepared and submitted in response to this RFQ are current, complete, true and accurate. Bidder acknowledges that Resolute will rely on such statements, information and representations in selecting the successful bidder. If selected by Resolute, bidder will notify Resolute immediately of any material change in any matters with regard to which bidder has made a statement or representation or provided information.
- 2.10 Bidder will defend, indemnify and hold harmless Resolute, its affiliates, and their respective directors, officers, agents and employees ("Representatives"), from and against all claims, actions, suits, demands, costs (including, but not limited to, reasonable attorneys' fees), damages and liabilities, arising out of, connected with, or resulting from any acts or omissions or wilful misconduct of bidder or one of its agents, employees, subcontractors, suppliers or any of its affiliates, subcontractors, suppliers and agents (or any of their respective directors, officers, employees or agents) in the execution or performance of any purchase order, contract or agreement resulting from this RFQ.
- 2.11 Bidder offers and agrees to provide the Products to and/or perform the Services for Resolute, and to comply with all terms, conditions, requirements and specifications set forth in this RFQ.
- 2.12 Bidder has not given or offered to give to Resolute or any of its Representatives nor does it intend to give at any time hereafter, any economic opportunity, future employment, gift, loan, gratuity, special discount, trip, favor or service in connection with its submitted quotation.
- 2.13 Bidder certifies that the individual signing this RFQ and any documents made part of this RFQ is authorized to sign all such documents on its behalf, and to bind bidder under any agreements and other contractual arrangements that may result from the submission of bidder's quotation.
- 2.14 Bidder certifies that other than the relationships which have been previously disclosed to Resolute in writing (i) no relationship, whether by blood, marriage, business association, capital funding agreement or any other such kinship or connection exists between the owner of any bidder that is a sole proprietorship, the officers or directors of any bidder that is a corporation, the partners of any bidder that is a partnership, the joint venturers of any bidder that is a joint venture or the members or managers of any bidder that is a limited liability company, on one hand, and an employee of any affiliate of Resolute, on the other hand, and (ii) bidder or any of its officers, directors and shareholders/partners has not been an employee of Resolute within the immediate twelve (12) months prior to the submittal deadline of this RFQ. All disclosures by bidder in connection with this

certification will be subject to administrative review and approval before Resolute enters into a purchase order, contract or agreement with bidder.

- 2.15 Bidder represents and warrants that all Services and Products offered to Resolute in response to this RFQ meet or exceed the safety standards established and promulgated under all applicable laws and regulations including, but without limitation, environmental and health and safety.
- 2.16 Bidder represents and warrants that no proceedings have been taken or authorized by it or by any other person with respect to the bankruptcy, insolvency, liquidation, dissolution or winding up of bidder nor, to the knowledge of bidder, has anyone threaten to take any such proceedings against it.
- 2.17 Bidder represents and warrants that no penal or criminal proceedings have been taken against it that could, in the opinion of Resolute, have an impact on bidder's ability to perform its obligations under this RFQ or any contract that may be granted by Resolute to bidder or, directly or indirectly, on the reputation of Resolute nor, to the knowledge of bidder, have any such proceedings been threatened by any person. Bidder undertakes to sign any authorization that could be required in order for Resolute to conduct, at its discretion, any and all searches to verify if any such penal or criminal proceedings have been taken or are pending against bidder.

3.0 Submission Requirements

- 3.1 **Contact:** All completed documents constituting your proposal, as well as any questions or clarifications concerning this RFQ must be submitted electronically to Resolute's representative identified on the front page of this RFQ.
- 3.2 **Timeline:** Proposals must be received on or before the submittal deadline (date and time) specified on the front page of this RFQ. Resolute reserves the right, but has no obligation, to accept a proposal submitted after the deadline and to amend the timeline. If a change to the timeline is required, Resolute will communicate the change to bidder(s). If a bidder requests an extension of a deadline, Resolute may, in its sole discretion, decide to allow the extension or not. Resolute may, in its sole discretion, decide whether or not to communicate to the other bidder(s) its granting of an extension or to offer them with the same extension.
- 3.3 **Validity:** All proposals must be firm and valid for a period of at least 90 days from the submittal deadline of this RFQ. Bidder will not be permitted to change the wording of its proposal after submission to Resolute.

4.0 Terms and Conditions

SCHEDULE 1 SCOPE OF WORK

Resolute FP Canada Inc. is seeking quotations for:

Resolute FP Canada Inc. is seeking quotations on the three following services for Resolute SFL's (Black Spruce, Caribou, Dog River-Matawin and English River Forests) and Boundary Waters Forest (on behalf of Boundary Waters Forest Management Corp.):

1. General cone collection, cone handling and shipping.
2. Orchard cone collection, cone handling and shipping.
3. Seed pre-treatment upgrading and shipping and returns.

Scope of Work:

Item 1. General cone collection, cone handling and shipping

The Company will set annually collection targets by forest and species, and whether general collection or orchard collection. The collection targets for 2024-2025 year are included in Schedule 4 to assist with completing the Pricing Worksheet Schedule 2.

Equipment:

- Cone volume measure device(s) (volume measure is by HI (hectoliter) (100L))
- Cone storage area that is dry, and temperature controlled in summer and fall
- Minor species cone trays, as well as fans and indoor space to allow for drying without mold
- Cone bags and tags
- Pallets and shipping supplies
- Any other equipment required to receive, move, handle, store and ship cones

Collection activities include:

- Organising and certifying Collectors with whom you intend to procure cones.
- Ensuring Collectors are trained to the Resolute EMS and safety related to safe travel on bush roads, proper requirements for approaching active harvest operations, working around operations once permission to do so is obtained by the operation, and any other safety requirement the Contractor deems necessary.
- Providing a collection package to Collectors with safety and collection information.
- Issuing a certificate to the Collector indicating that the Collector has been trained and the collector is approved for collection in Resolute operating areas.
- Specifying how and when PPE and safety audits of Collectors will be conducted, refer to Resolute Rep. for PPE requirements.
- Demonstrated competency to grade cones for payment and quality control.
- Ensuring all burlap bags and fasteners required for collection are provided to Collectors.
- Providing payment to the Collector for cones received.
- Issuing advertisements to attract Collectors as required and necessary.
- Collecting by ecodistrict. Collection targets specified in Schedule 4 include the ecodistricts collection targeted in by species and forest. In 2020, the Province issued an updated policy that identified ecodistricts as the area within which seed is collected and bags are labeled to; this replaces the old seed numbered seed zones. An ecodistrict map is included with the old numbered seed zone information for reference only. See Schedule 5.

Cone handling and shipment activities include:

- Provision of burlap bags or screened trays to be used to store and ship cones.

- Ensuring proper handling of trayed cones. Screened trays require good air circulation often with the assistance of fans. Good air flow must be maintained around trays and the cone condition monitored for mold and heat conditions while in the Contractors care.
- Ensuring proper storage of cones. Storage of cones in trailers requires cooling during the summer and fall, and good air circulation. Trays may not be stored in trailers where air flow is hindered, or where easy access to turning cones and testing for mold and heat cannot be done. Trays may not be wrapped in plastic film while being stored. During shipment trays may be wrapped in plastic film with good air gaps no earlier than the day prior to shipment.
- Ensuring shipping is completed to maximize cone quality. Shipment of jack pine may be scheduled as loads are full. The extraction plant is located in Timmins Ontario. Shipment of minor species stored on cone trays is expected for white spruce, by Sept 15th, for the other minor species, by Nov. 15th. Minor species received after this, as long as handling conditions are followed may be shipped no later than Dec. 15th.
- Shipment of cones to the extraction plant currently under contract to a facility in Timmins Ontario.

Item 2. Orchard cone collection, cone handling and shipping

Orchard collections may not occur annually. Orchard collections are depended on available cone crops in the orchards. An amount by forest will be allocated in the annual targets for collection, with estimates provided in Schedule 4; however the Company will determine annually, by September 15, where and if any collection from orchards will be conducted. Orchard maintenance work may also be required. For example, removal of dead trees, brushing along roads to improve access etc.

Equipment and training:

- Provision personnel with appropriate and applicable training
- All equipment required to safely top black spruce and jack pine trees (usually at 16 feet), transport tops, collect on site or at the Contractor premises. This may include, but not be limited to:
 - PPE
 - Topping and chain saws
 - Trucks, quads and trailers
 - Pruning clippers
 - Top disposal equipment (burn barrel or chipper)
- All equipment and services pertaining to item 1 related to cone handling, shipping and storage.

Locations:

- Orchards near Thunder Bay: Kakabeka (Pj), 25th Side Road (Sb), Partridge Falls (Sb), Kriekman (Sb)
- Orchards between Raith and Ignace: Nikullasson (Sb), Ferguson (Sb)
- Orchards near Sioux Lookout: Skurban (Sb), Goodie Lake South (Sb)
- Boundary Waters orchards: Morson (Sb and Pj- West End), Manion (Sb- central)

Item 3. Seed pre-treatment upgrading and shipping and returns

Preamble:

Annually, seed destined for greenhouse use is pre-treated from December through April with a variety of pre-treatments specified by seed condition statistics. These treatments include: Prevac, stratification, Incubation, Drying and Separation (IDS), Density Separation (DS), germination testing and seed drying. Other treatments may be required such as lot cleaning treatment or handling returned seed to reduce moisture content. Post-treatment seed shipment to growers is also required. Approximately 40 lots per year are treated which represents seed for 13 million seedlings. Seed returned from the aerial seed program is also handled to repackage, ensure correct moisture content and ship to extraction facility.

Equipment and training:

- All equipment and training required to conduct the following process:
 - Seed storage for lots prior to or after treatment both refrigeration and freezer
 - Aeriated soak
 - Prevac
 - IDS
 - DS
 - Germination testing
 - Stratification, including temperature monitoring
 - Seed drying
 - Scales, various lab items such as germination containers, bags, tags
 - Autoclave
 - Any other equipment required to receive, track and ship the seed such as a supply of insulated boxes.

Activities:

- Contractor is responsible for:
 - Shipment and receiving of seed.
 - Ensuring any treatment is conducted to maintain the quality of the seed.
 - Scheduling and completion of seed treatment to ensure germination testing is completed on a schedule provided annually by the Company.
 - Providing instructions and seed treatment summaries to the grower through documentation provided with the seed shipment.
 - Providing seed treatments summaries electronically to the Company.
